2. **All due consideration shall be given to all residents for access to and from their residential address.**
3. **That the area be barricaded off along with flood lighting and flashing lights to be placed on the barricades during the hours of darkness.**
4. **That warning signs be erected around the area.**
5. **That a safe area be left for pedestrian traffic in the area.**
6. **That the attached road closure notification is to be circulated in the area advertising the upcoming road closure.**
7. **That the traffic will be controlled by stop and go signs or Police Officer on Special Duty.**
8. **That all Transport Department conditions will be complied with.**
9. **Any deviation from any of these conditions will cause this permit to become invalid and the work will be ceased immediately until authorisation is given for the work to recommence**
10. **This permit can be cancelled at any time if traffic is delayed to delayed periods or any condition is breached.**

Traffic Control Permit Conditions:

Conditions *specific* to permit number TCP15723

Traffic control, including the implementation of traffic control devices, shall only be performed by suitably qualified employees of the applicant, a Traffic Management Company currently registered with the Department of Transport and Main Roads (DTMR), whose name appears on the front of this permit.

- a) The applicant **must** notify DTMR South Coast Region Traffic Management Centre by calling **1800 131940** a minimum of one (1) hour prior to going on site and immediately after leaving site each day. A contact name and phone number of the responsible person on site **must** be supplied.
- b) This permit is **only valid** for the times, dates and location specified and is **not** transferrable. The applicant must contact the DTMR South Coast Region Permit Team to discuss any changes and obtain written approval of changes to the permit prior to conducting any works and/or event.
- c) This permit refers only to permission for the installation of temporary traffic control for the nominated work and/or event site and **does not** negate the need for the applicant to have all other necessary approvals required by another authority, occupier or owner, eg Queensland Police Service, DTMR, Local Government, private property owner, lease holder etc. Failure to obtain such approvals and/or meet the conditions of such approvals will result in the immediate cancellation of this Traffic Control Permit (TCP).
- d) The applicant must contact and advise all Public Transport Service authorities of any lane or road closures or the need to relocate services such as a designated bus stop prior to going on site. The email address for TransLink is temporary.closures@translink.com.au
- e) The applicant must contact and advise all Emergency Service Authorities of any lane or road closures.
- f) All works and/or events on the Pacific Motorway and/or the Smith Street Motorway **must** have the following:
 - Police on duty and/or bump truck for the duration of the works and/or event; and
 - Pre-warning trailer mounted variable message signs (VMS) 1km prior to the works advising of lane closures.
- g) The Deed of Indemnity submitted by the Applicant with the TCP application applies to anything done under or in connection with this TCP without limitation.
- h) In the absence of functioning traffic signals traffic must be controlled by Queensland Police Service.

On site the applicant **must** ensure the following:

- i) A copy of this TCP is on site and made available for inspection by DTMR or local council representatives.
- ii) All operations are conducted according to the current version of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).
- iii) Placement of signage must take in to account the site topography of hillcrests, curves and prevailing weather conditions at all times. Additional signage may be needed on risk assessment of these conditions.
- iv) An accurate sketch/diary is maintained of regulatory signage in place at any time during works.
- v) Traffic controllers are qualified, registered and certified personnel employed by the applicant. Proof of accreditation must be carried on all persons at all times whilst in the work site and/or event area for the duration of works and/or event.
- vi) The 'Approved Procedure for Controlling Traffic' and all Workplace Health and Safety Regulations must be followed.
- vii) A safe thoroughfare is provided for pedestrians and/or traffic with minimum disruption. Personnel should be isolated and not conflict with traffic.
- viii) All traffic control devices are removed or covered when not in use.

In the event that traffic delays are excessive or too disruptive, DTMR reserves the right to direct the Contractor and/or the Traffic Control Company to cease work and reopen closures.

DTMR may cancel the permit immediately if you fail to comply with the above conditions or cause a safety hazard by neglecting your public liability responsibilities.
