

Activity 3

Applying for a plumbing approval with Gold Coast City Council

1. Go to the Gold Coast City Council website: Planning and Building; Building & Plumbing; Plumbing & drainage; types of plumbing applications

2. Click on Residential Applications
3. Click on Submit sewerage application
4. Search for property address either by Lot No / Plan type or address
5. Click on address
6. Enter the details of the parties associated with the submission ie Applicant and Owner mandatory, Contact Person
7. Click on Next
8. Fill in the application details:
 - Building class type 01A detached single dwelling house
 - Application components
 - Click next
9. Upload supporting documents:
 - Form 1 Compliance assessment application for plumbing, drainage and on-site sewerage work (found on the Qld Gov't website)
 - Plans – eg hydraulic drawings, site plan, floor plans, stormwater, architectural and civil drawings etc
 - Soil report
 - Any other additional supporting documents
10. Refer to the Gold Coast City Council water and sewerage for any additional applications that may be required e.g. new water meter
11. Click on Next and Confirm the details are correct.

Plumbing inspections and approvals must be obtained at the following stages of the build:

Underslab before the slab is poured

Roughin – Internal plumbing installed prior to walls

Final – all items fitted off & hot water running etc, close to completion
