Nursery Plant Propagation

ACTIVITY ONE

For cuttings, place in water or wrap in wet newspaper and store in a cool, dry place.

ACTIVITY TWO

Seeds should be packaged according to enterprise guidelines and stored in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, such as an air conditioned room.

ACTIVITY THREE

When stored correctly, seeds can be kept for several years.

ACTIVITY FOUR

To plant seeds you may use germination trays.

ACTIVITY FIVE

As a general rule, provide information such as the type of plant and when it was replanted.

ACTIVITY SIX

Always wear a dust mask when dealing with potting mix and wash your hands thoroughly after use, even if you were wearing gloves.

ACTIVITY SEVEN

Either of these answers is acceptable:

- Dirty and messy work areas are a safety risk
- Dirty and messy work areas can help spread diseases

ACTIVITY EIGHT

Inorganic waste that cannot be recycled should be taken to an authorised landfill site.
